Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) continues to be an important area of focus for Heritage Petroleum. Heritage's CSR policy is rooted in support for education, environmental sustainability and social interventions with a focus on sustainability in development. These are some of the initiatives of the Heritage Petroleum CSR Programme:

EDUCATION

- HERO (Heritage Education Resource Opportunity): Each year, four top performing SEA students from fenceline primary schools are offered scholarships of \$100,000 to cover education expenses from Form One to Bachelor's degree. In 2020, the first cohort of students benefitted from this initiative and we are set to again distribute these awards in 2021
- Approximately 500 computers distributed to students to facilitate online learning
- Sponsorship of the La Brea Student Support Centre
- Sponsorship of the Palo Seco Diatonics Youth Music Literacy Programme
- Onboarding of 20 graduate trainees for two-year internship
