



'This is Our Heritage' FACEBOOK DIGITAL POSTER COMPETITION RULES

Please read **ALL** the rules as entries not meeting the criteria, will not be accepted or eligible for consideration.

1. Participants are required to develop a digital poster using a minimum of three original photos, showcasing aspects of T&T's cultural, architectural, food, environmental or people heritage. The poster **MUST** also include a quote or line from the "This is Our Heritage" anthem, as part of the copy.
2. There is no required size/dimension given for the poster.
3. The Heritage Poster Competition is being held strictly on the Facebook platform. Only posters posted to Facebook will be eligible and judged.
4. All digital posters submitted as part of the Facebook Poster Challenge, **MUST** tag the Heritage Petroleum Facebook handle (@heritagepetroleum) and **MUST** include the following hashtags (#heritageisweown #thisisourheritagett #heritagepetroleum) in the caption.
5. In addition to posting, tagging and properly captioning, all entrants **MUST** follow the Heritage Petroleum page and direct message (DM) the Heritage page, sharing the link to the post along with:
 - o Your Full Name (if group one person should DM with Full Name of group members)
 - o Email Address and Mobile Contact
 - o Residential Address
 - o A brief description of the artwork and the inspiration behind it
6. Only the poster posted by the participant who submitted details to the Heritage page via DM, will be eligible for judging. One person may post for the group and the others can share that post.
7. The competition is open to residents of Trinidad & Tobago only. Only videos posted by residents will be eligible and judged.
8. Enter as an individual or group entry (a maximum of 4 people) ****Please read terms and conditions on the following page.**
9. Any AI-generated content or content not originally made by entrants, WILL NOT be eligible for consideration. All photos, artwork, videos and audio (apart from the This is Our Heritage anthem) should be originally captured and produced. Where any element is not owned by the participant is used, credit to the source/owner must be given.
10. Any use of inappropriate content, profanity, or racial terms in a review is grounds for removal and disqualification. This also includes explicit content, offensive content, hate speech, harassment, and bullying.
11. Only first, second and third place winners will be selected for cash prizes
 - o 1st prize: \$20,000
 - o 2nd prize: \$10,000
 - o 3rd prize: \$5,000
12. Winners will be selected based upon:
 - o The most likes on the original post
 - o The most shares/reposts of the originally post
 - o Creativity, originality, and adherence to the competition theme
13. The Heritage Digital Poster competition will run from Friday 19th July to Wednesday 25th September, 2024.
14. Winners will be selected and contacted between 30th September and 4th October, 2024 by a Heritage official. **Please Note:** If you do not receive an email and phone call within this period, it means that your entry didn't gain enough votes by the deadline date, to be awarded a prize.
